

TOURNAMENT RULES
“MONSTERSTACK MYSTERY BOUNTY”
JUNE 25th – 26th, 2025

REGENCY ENTERTAINMENT Tourism & Leisure Single Person S.A. introduces “MONSTERSTACK MYSTERY BOUNTY” tournament on the date specified below. The tournament will take place on June 25th and 26th 2025, and is subject to the following terms and conditions:

GENERAL TOURNAMENT PARTICIPATION RIGHT

Participation is allowed to persons who legally enter the casino, in accordance with the legislation governing the casino (Law 2206/1994, Law 4512/2018) as in force, and the decision of the HGC No. 303/4/2018 (Government Gazette B' 979/19-03-2018) abolishing the obligation to issue entrance tickets, as well as with the decision T/6736/2003 of the Ministry of Development entitled "Regulation of Administrative Control and Supervision of Casino Operation" (B' 929), as amended and codified by the no. 303/5/27.02.2018 (B' 1025) decision of the HGC and in force.

1. TOURNAMENT DESCRIPTION

- 1.1. The Tournament will take place in Vergina Theatre of Regency Casino Thessaloniki, on June 25th and 26th 2025, starting at 15:00 p.m. and 14:00 p.m. respectively.
- 1.2. Twenty (20) tables of nine (9) seats will be used for the Tournament with a maximum of one hundred and eighty 180 number of participants.
- 1.3. The Tournament organizer has the right to increase the maximum number of participants if necessary.
- 1.4. Blind bet levels increase according to the table in 3.17 paragraph of the current Tournament regulation.
- 1.5. Tournament chips are exclusively used during the tournament. A special chip, called Bounty Chip is also added to the aforementioned Tournament Chips and is not redeemable. Its value is set at paragraph 3.1, deducted from the total participation fee and evenly distributed among players as indicated on the payment table of paragraph 3.4 , 3.9 and 3.11.

2. TOURNAMENT PARTICIPATION LIMITATIONS

- 2.1. Participation in the Tournament is prohibited for senior executives, including company's permanent advisors and their up-to-second-degree relatives, as well as any company partner who participates in this process in any way.

3. TOURNAMENT PROCEDURE

- 3.1. All participants must submit an entry stake of four hundred Euro (€400) two hundred (€200) of which correspond to the value of the total tournament chips amount, two hundred thousand (200.000) points, while the remaining two hundred euro (€200) in a special Bounty Chip.
- 3.2. All participants must submit a tournament registration fee of fifty Euro (€50).
- 3.3. Participants have the right of re-entry for the amount of four hundred and fifty Euro (€450) for tournament chips of two hundred thousand (200,000) points value, as well as for a new elimination chip. Money is distributed as set out in paragraph 3.1. All participants can make unlimited re-entries, withing the first ten (10) blind bet levels time period, as long as their entire initial chip stack is lost.
- 3.4. In this particular tournament the bounty will be activated ITM on day 2. The total mystery bounty prize corresponds to the total number of registrations plus 200 Euro. After the

completion of day 1, the total mystery bounty amount is divided into amounts, the total number of which is the total mystery bounty prize. Each amount goes into a sealed envelope with the total amount of envelopes corresponding to the total of players who are in the money. Each time a player eliminates another, they win a random mystery bounty envelope. The player is provided with an exclusion card by the inspector, on the indication of which they are entitled to randomly choose a sealed envelope. The specific player wins the amount written inside the envelope, redeemable only at the central casino cashier desk. Each player is allowed to have more than one envelopes .

- 3.5. Entries are completed before the beginning of the eleventh level of blind bets, as defined by the Betting Structure Table in paragraph 3.17.
- 3.6. Each participant's position will be randomly determined through a computerized system or an alternative random selection method. In the event that participants who are related or connected by any other relationship are selected to play at the same table, their positions must be changed.
- 3.7. The dealer button position will be determined through a draw carried out only in the first table of the tournament and its result will be valid for all tables.
- 3.8. In case a player does not take the position assigned to them by the seats' draw process, all initial blind and mandatory bets are deducted for each betting round from their specified chips amount and added to the pot, until they occupy their assigned position. The player's seat at the table receives a card and retains all rights as if that player had been present at the table to begin with. If the player has not claimed their position by the completion of the first ten (10) levels of the tournament, then the position and the player are voided and the remaining chips are withdrawn from the tournament. The value of the Bounty Chip is added to the first winner's prize.
- 3.9. Tournament chips are exclusively used during the tournament. Bounty Chip cannot be used in the tournament, but must be handed over by the player who is eliminated from the tournament to the player who eliminated them and cannot be redeemed at the cashier.
- 3.10. The tournament will be a No Limit Texas Hold'em game.
- 3.11. The final tournament prize consists of all participants' entry stakes total, as well as the amount collected from the repurchase of tokens, as described in paragraph 3.3. The amount corresponding to the value of the Bounty Chips is deducted from the entry stakes total and the remainder is distributed among the winners, as follows:

- 3.12. In order to register, prospective participants may address themselves at the Poker Room or the Main Cashier, in order to obtain a participation application. Having filled out their participation application all participants pay the amount of the registration fee to the Main Cashier of the Casino.
- 3.13. Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 3.14. Each participation is strictly personal and cannot be transferred to another candidate.
- 3.15. If a candidate has paid the entry stake and the tournament registration fee for the competition and does not wish to participate, they must inform the casino at least twenty-four (24) hours

prior to the start of the tournament. In this case, the casino refunds both the entry stake and the tournament registration fee. In case the participant fails to inform the casino in twenty-four (24) hours, prior to the beginning of the tournament, only the entry stake is returned to the prospective participant, while the tournament registration fee remains in the entry fee box. The tournament registration fee is returned to the prospective participant, only if his place is filled by another candidate who wishes to participate in the tournament.

- 3.16. Each participant is solely responsible for the protection of their hand and their proper participation in the tournament.
- 3.17. The increase of blind bets is carried out every thirty minutes (30') during Day 1 and forty minutes (40') on Day 2, according to the Betting Structure Table as follows:

All breaks are carried out according to the table above unless the Tournament Organizer thinks otherwise. When the final table is created, another ten (10) minute break is in order.

- 3.18. Ante bets are placed on each round by the player who is required to place a big blind bet and must be equal to the big blind bet. In case the player does not have enough chips for both bets, "ANTE" is given priority and if there is a remainder, it is held for the Big Blind. The player cannot claim more points than the "ANTE" unless they have enough chips to cover the Big Blind or part of it and can only claim the amount they have bet.
- 3.19. The game begins with the dealer collecting and shuffling all the cards. Any bet increase flagged by the tournament's computerized Management System, takes place after the game in progress is completed.
- 3.20. Each player's chips remain on the table, in such a way that the highest value is visible to all players. This must continue, until each game period is completed. The casino reserves the right to remove chips from the table, that have been deliberately hidden.
- 3.21. Participants active in a "hand", have the right to ask the amount of chips available to another active participant in the same "hand". If a participant does not wish to reveal this information, the dealer counts the chips and answers the question.
- 3.22. Should all participants in the same "hand", go all-in and there's no further betting, it is mandatory the show all cards faced up in order for the dealing to be continued.
- 3.23. Only tournament chips can be used in the game.
- 3.24. Should, during the same "hand", two (or more) participants of the same table are eliminated from the game, the positions occupied by them, in the tournament ranking, are proportional to the amount of chips they held, before the commencement of that particular "hand" (the one during which they were eliminated).
- 3.25. Should, during the same "hand", two participants from different tables are eliminated from the game, they occupy the same ranking position in the tournament, regardless the amount of chips they had, before the commencement of the specific "hand" (the one during which they were eliminated).
- 3.26. During race off process, each player receives a maximum of one chip. The process begins from the first player positioned to the left of the dealer button and includes all players who hold chips of the value that is being removed.
- 3.27. Players are not allowed to leave the table until the dealer has completed the initial deal. The dealer, after having completed the initial deal and before starting the hand, collects the cards from all empty positions. Mandatory and blind bets are collected and placed in the pot.
- 3.28. To ensure a smooth operation, the casino has the right to move players from one table to another in order to maintain balance between tables, as follows:

Before the race off process of 100-point chips and 500-point chips or until the closure of late registration, the difference between two players, from table to table, is acceptable. However, after the 100-point and 500-point chips race off process or after the closure of late registration the difference between tables is balanced, when feasible. In addition, for the above reason, the casino reserves the right to cease the tournament on the table with the fewest players, until the players' transfer from one table to another is completed.

- 3.29 Each player has two minutes to act. After this interval, any active or non-active player of the table, has the right to request "time". The one player whose turn is to play, will be given an additional minute to decide. If after this one minute the player has not yet made a decision, a ten-second countdown takes place. In the event that players are found to be delaying their decisions in order to influence the outcome of the tournament in their favor, the Tournament Organizer reserves the right to force all players to make a decision within a certain time frame until the end of the tournament. In any case, when while in the process where the remaining players or the positions of the winners are more than the prizes by one, then all players are obliged to answer within ten (10') seconds, unless the Tournament Organizer approves of a time extension. If the player has not made a decision within the allotted time then his hand is declared "fold" if he faces a bet or "check" if he does not.

4. BOUNTY CHIP TERMS

- 4.1. When the game begins, the dealer of each table hands the players a Bounty Chip.
- 4.2. As soon as a player announces their intention to go "All-In" they place their Bounty Chip in front of them. In case of disqualification, the disqualified player's Bounty Chip is handed over to the winner of the pass.
- 4.3. If there is an "All-in" with more than two players, the eliminated player's Bounty Chip is handed over to the player who wins the relevant pot and not necessarily the best hand in the round .
- 4.4. In the event that more than one hand proves to be equal and jointly wins the pot in which a player has been banned, then the value of the Bounty Chip is divided equally between the winners up to five euro (€5). If five euro (€5) remains, it is awarded to the first active player after the Dealer's marker.
- 4.5. Players' won Bounty Chips must not be mixed with their other tournament chips. This may result in a penalty or disqualification according to the discretion of the Tournament Organizer.
- 4.6. A player who eliminates an opponent is handed only their Bounty Chip and not all the other Tournament Chips the player had from previous bans.
- 4.7. Players who have won other players' Bounty Chips, must hand them in to the Tournament Organizer as soon as they themselves are disqualified and fill in a special form indicating the value of these chips, in order to receive the amount at the Casino Main Cashier Desk.
- 4.8. If a player is eliminated from the remainder of the competition, then the value of the Bounty Chip is added to the prize of the first winner.

5. OTHER TERMS

- 5.1. In order to facilitate the validity of your participation, on the day of the tournament you need to hand over your registration form to the dealer and also an identification document (ID, drivers licence, passport etc), once your table and position are announced.
- 5.2. In case a candidate is found to have given up their position to another candidate, then the former is disqualified from the tournament. Entry stake and tournament registration fee remain in the pot and the entry fee box. Participation in the competition requires the appearance of all players in person, excluding their replacement by another player in any way.
- 5.3. Players are not allowed to use a mobile phone for any reason during the tournament. The aforementioned violation results in the said player cards being voided, as well as in the bets (blind bets and mandatory included) being remained in the pot and the specific player is disqualified from the tournament.
- 5.4. The sale or purchase of tournament chips between players is prohibited. Any player found violating this rule, is immediately disqualified from the tournament, the remaining of their chips are removed from the table and the registration fee remains in the drop box.

5.5. During the tournament players are not allowed to:

1. Sit in a position other than the selected and/or indicated by the Casino
2. Verbally abuse or use physical violence against a Casino employee or a third party
3. Act out of sequence
4. Reveal closed cards before any action
5. Hide closed cards when they should be revealed
6. Act with intention to remove one or more cards from the table
7. Act intentionally to avoid paying a blind bet, when moving to a table in order to balance it (all blind bets that are not placed, are paid and placed into the next pot as inactive money)
8. Do not move directly to an indicated table, to balance it
9. Communicate or cooperate with each other or with other parties, in any way, with the intention of influencing the outcome of the tournament.
10. Violate the tournament terms and conditions or behave in such a way that is harmful to its smooth operation.

Such violations result in a verbal warning or even the disqualification of the player from one or more rounds of the tournament, as well as banning from the table for a specified (and progressively increasing) period of time. The above may also result in all of the player bets (mandatory and blind bets included) remaining in the pot or even their permanent disqualification from the tournament.

- 5.6. When a player is disqualified their remaining chips are removed from the rest of the tournament.
- 5.7. Customers' details are processed by the company exclusively for tournament purposes. The company may contact the customer by phone in order to inform them about the tournament.
- 5.8. Tournament players sign an agreement in advance, where they consent to the use of their photo and name in publications, advertisements and any other means of communication (TV, Internet, Radio, Newspapers etc.) approved by Regency Entertainment Tourism and Leisure Single Person S.A., in case they are declared winners of the tournament.
- 5.9. All aforementioned tournament terms are available in the Casino website and in the Casino Table Games area.
- 5.10. Candidates are solely responsible to be informed about the terms of the tournament.
- 5.11. By participating in the Tournament, all players accept that the conditions of the terms of the present are exclusively controlled by the company.

- 5.12 All participants in the Tournament accept that Regency Entertainment Tourism and Leisure Single Person S.A. reserves the right to cancel the tournament, extend it or change and modify the terms and conditions of its conduct, whenever necessary.
- 5.13 In the event of force majeure or any other reason hindering the occurrence of the Tournament on the specified date, the Tournament will either be canceled or rescheduled for another date and time, indicated by Regency Entertainment Tourism and Leisure Single Person S.A.
- 5.14 The Tournament is certified by the present representatives of the Casino and it is final and not amenable to disputes.

2. What Personal Data do we collect?

- ✓ Name: we collect the first and the last name of our customers when they fill out the registration form, or sign up for our newsletter, or participate in our contests, draws and various promotions.
- ✓ Date of birth and nationality: we collect the date of birth and nationality of our customers when they complete their registration form.
- ✓ Email address, postal address details and mobile phone number: they are collected by registering and participating in tournaments, draws and promotions.

- ✓ Financial and Professional information: such as a settlement note or other documents using Tax Office information, work certificates and a recent payroll copy, required by the law.
- ✓ Information regarding customers' gaming activity: during the provision of our services, required by the law.
- ✓ On line activity data: when company's digital services are used, personal data such as social media account, profile picture, IP address etc. is collected. If the customer chooses to link his/her social media account with the company's digital services, his/her personal data and information may be shared by his/her social media account.
- ✓ Suppliers' & Partners' Details: Suppliers' & Partners' names, registered office address, VAT number, Tax Office Number, IBAN Number etc. are collected for operating and invoicing purposes.

3. How do we collect your personal data?

We collect your personal data through the registration application during your first visit to the casino, when show interest in our services, when you visit our website, or when you subscribe to our newsletter. We do not share your personal data with anyone and we guarantee that no use is made other than as provided by law.

4. Customers' Personal Data is used for:

- ✓ Provision of our services: casino entrance, participation in casino games and videotaped poker tournaments.
- ✓ Marketing and other promotions, such as participation in draws and tournaments, newsletters, digital communication etc.
- ✓ Rewarding and awarding of points and benefits.
- ✓ Information regarding an imposing of entry ban or exit from the Casino area.
- ✓ Prevention of money laundering and terrorist financing, in accordance with the law.

5. Lawful basis of processing Personal Data:

- ✓ Personal Data processing is performed for various regulatory and legal obligations of all Casinos towards the Competent Authorities, in the context of our compliance with national and/or European legislation.
- ✓ Personal Data processing is performed for marketing and/or promotional purposes, based on the customer's consent.
- ✓ In some cases, Personal Data processing is necessary for legitimate interests' purposes, provided that the customer's rights and legitimate interests do not outweigh the rights of the company.
- ✓ Finally, Personal Data processing, is carried out for reasons of public interest, to avoid money laundering and terrorist financing.

6. Duration of Personal Data records maintaining:

- ✓ Maintaining customers' personal data records is required by law.
- ✓ Customers' personal data records regarding rewarding and loyalty programs (points), is maintained for a period of three (3) months or for the last twenty (20) visits.
- ✓ Personal data records regarding suppliers and other partners, are maintained for twenty (20) years, according to tax and administrative authorities requirements.

- ✓ Personal data records regarding customers who registered for company's newsletter and other promotions, until personally declared by the customer otherwise.

7. Precautionary Measurements for our Customers' Personal Data Protection
