

TOURNAMENT RULES
“MEGA SATELLITE FOR GREEK POKER ODYSSEA”

REGENCY ENTERTAINMENT Tourism & Leisure Single Person S.A. introduces “MEGA SATELLITE for Greek Poker Odyssey”. The tournament will take place on June 25th , 2025 and is subject to the following terms and conditions:

GENERAL TOURNAMENT PARTICIPATION RIGHT

Participation is allowed to persons who legally enter the casino, in accordance with the legislation governing the casino (Law 2206/1994, Law 4512/2018) as in force, and the decision of the HGC No. 303/4/2018 (Government Gazette B' 979/19-03-2018) abolishing the obligation to issue entrance tickets, as well as with the decision T/6736/2003 of the Ministry of Development entitled "Regulation of Administrative Control and Supervision of Casino Operation" (B' 929), as amended and codified by the no. 303/5/27.02.2018 (B' 1025) decision of the HGC and in force.

1. TOURNAMENT DESCRIPTION

- 1.1. The Tournament will take place in Vergina Theatre of Regency Casino Thessaloniki on June 25th 2025 at 20:30 p.m.
- 1.2. Thirteen (13) tables of ten (9) seats will be used for the tournament.
- 1.3. Blind bet levels will be increasing every 15' minutes.
- 1.4. Minimum number of participants is set at 5.

2. TOURNAMENT PARTICIPATION LIMITATIONS

- 2.1. Participation in the Tournament is prohibited for senior executives, including company's permanent advisors and their up-to-second-degree relatives, as well as any company partner who participates in this process in any way.

3. TOURNAMENT PROCEDURE

- 3.1. All participants must submit an entry stake of one hundred twenty (120€), which corresponds to the value of the total tournament chips amount, thirty thousand (30.000) points.
- 3.2. In order to participate in the tournament, players must submit to the casino a tournament registration fee, which is 12,5% of the initial chip bank value, meaning fifteen Euro (15€).
- 3.3. Participants have the right of a re-entry to the tournament for the amount of one hundred and thirty five euros (135€) for tournament chips worth (30,000) points. Anyone can make one re-entry provided they have lost their initial chip stack (30,000) and within a time frame of the first eight (8) levels.
- 3.4. Each participant's position will be randomly determined through a computerized system or an alternative random selection method. In the event that participants who are related or connected by any other relationship are selected to play at the same table, their positions must be changed. The Casino reserves the right to change their position at its discretion.
- 3.5. In cases where a participant does not claim the seat assigned to them by the seat draw process, at the beginning of the tournament, within the eight (8) level time period, all initial blinds and mandatory bets are deducted from the designated chip amount for each round of betting and are added to the pot, until they take the position they have been assigned to. The participant's seat at the table receives cards and retains all rights. After the eight (8) level

period, they lose the right to participate in the tournament and their chips are removed from the table.

- 3.6. Tournament chips are exclusively used during the tournament.
- 3.7. The tournament will be a No Limit Texas Hold'em game.
- 3.8. The final tournament prize consists of all participants' entry stakes total. Prizes will be paid as follows, the first €600 (and each subsequent €600 topped up) will go towards the payment of the GREEK POKER ODYSSEA tournament 'ticket' or 'tickets' for Day 1A (26/6/25) and the remaining amounts will be given to the winners in cash, e.g.:

1st Winner: €600 (€530 for participation + €70 for registration cost)

2nd Winner: €600 (€530 for participation + €70 for registration cost), or the remaining amount of money, after the first winner's prize payment.

3rd Winner: €600 (€530 for participation + €70 for registration cost), or the remaining amount of money, after the second winner's prize payment.

4th Winner: €600 (€530 for participation + €70 for registration cost), or the remaining amount of money, after the third winner's prize payment.

5th Winner: €600 (€530 for participation + €70 for registration cost), or the remaining amount of money, after the fourth winner's prize payment etc.

- 3.9. In order to register, prospective participants must pay the entry and registration fee to the Main Casino Cashier by the end of the first eight levels, subject to availability.
- 3.10. Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 3.11. Each participation application is strictly personal and non-transferable. Satellite tournament prizes are not redeemable unless the participant has already won a ticket to a previous satellite tournament.
- 3.12. In case of cancellation, the position will be covered by the first person on a waiting list of maximum ten (10) people, which will be maintained in order to facilitate such incidents. Candidates in the waiting list must be present in the poker room thirty (30) minutes before the game starts, in order to maintain their position in the waiting list.
- 3.13. In cases when a candidate has paid the entry stake and the tournament registration fee for the competition and does not wish to participate, they must inform the casino at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the start of the tournament. In this case, the casino refunds both the entry stake and the tournament registration fee. In case the participant fails to inform the casino in twenty-four (24) hours, prior to the beginning of the tournament, only the entry stake is returned to the prospective participant, while the tournament registration fee remains in the entry fee box. The tournament registration fee is returned to the prospective participant, only if all tournament seats are filled by other candidates who wish to participate in the tournament.
- 3.14. Each participant is solely responsible for the protection of their hand and their proper participation in the tournament.
- 3.15. The increase of blind bets is carried out every fifteen minutes (15'), according to the Betting Structure Table as follows:

- 3.16. The game begins with the dealer collecting and shuffling all the cards. Any bet increase flagged by the tournament's Computerized Management System will take place after the in-progress lot has been completed.
- 3.17. Each player's chips remain on the table, in such a way that the highest value is visible to all players. This must continue, until each game period is completed. The casino reserves the right to remove chips from the table, that have been deliberately hidden.
- 3.18. Participants active in a "hand", have the right to ask the amount of chips available to another active participant in the same "hand". If a participant does not wish to reveal this information, the dealer counts the chips and answers the question.
- 3.19. Should all participants in the same "hand", go all-in and there's no further betting, it is mandatory to show all cards faced up in order for the dealing to be continued.
- 3.20. Only tournament chips can be used in the game.

- 3.21. Should, during the same “hand”, two (or more) participants of the same table are eliminated from the game, the positions occupied by them, in the tournament ranking, are proportional to the amount of chips they held, before the commencement of that particular “hand” (the one during which they were eliminated).
- 3.22. Should, during the same “hand”, two participants from different tables are eliminated from the game, they occupy the same ranking position in the tournament, regardless the amount of chips they had, before the commencement of the specific “hand” (the one during which they were eliminated).
- 3.23. When the number of the remaining participants, in two or more tables of the same tournament, exceeds the permit by one, the number of participants determined by tournament terms, share the prize, either equally or depending on the total amount/points of the chips held by each player at the end of the tournament, then the dealer of each table must deal the cards of each hand at his table at the same time with the dealers of the other tables (hand for hand).
- 3.24. During race off process, each player receives a maximum of one chip. The process begins from the first player positioned to the left of the dealer button and includes all players who hold lower value chips.
- 3.25. Players are not allowed to leave the table until the dealer has completed the initial deal. The dealer, after having completed the initial deal and before starting the hand, collects the cards from all empty positions. Mandatory and blind bets are collected and placed in the pot.
- 3.26. To ensure a smooth operation, the casino has the right to move players from one table to another in order to maintain balance between tables, as follows:
Before the race off process of 100-point chips and 500-point chips or until the closure of late registration, the difference between two players, from table to table, is acceptable. However, after the 100-point and 500-point chips race off process or after the closure of late registration the difference between tables is balanced, when feasible. In addition, for the above reason, the casino reserves the right to cease the tournament on the table with the fewest players, until the players’ transfer from one table to another is completed.
- 3.27. Each player has two minutes to act. After this interval, any active or non-active player of the table, has the right to request “time”. The one player whose turn is to play, will be given an additional minute to decide. If after this one minute the player has not yet made a decision, a ten-second countdown takes place and if exceeded, the player’s card (hand) is void.
- 3.28. Ante bets are placed on each round by the player who is required to place a big blind bet and must be equal to the big blind bet. In case the player does not have enough chips for both bets, "ANTE" is given priority and if there is a remainder, it is held for the Big Blind. The player cannot claim more points than the “ANTE” unless they have enough chips to cover the Big Blind or part of it and can only claim the amount they have bet.

4. OTHER TERMS

- 4.1. In order to facilitate the validity of your participation, on the day of the tournament you need to hand over your registration form to the dealer and also an identification document (ID, drivers licence, passport etc), once your table and position are announced
- 4.2. Telephone reservations are not accepted.
- 4.3. In case a candidate is found to have given up their position to another candidate, then the former is disqualified from the tournament. Entry stake and tournament registration fee

remain in the pot and the entry fee box. Participation in the competition requires the appearance of all players in person, excluding their replacement by another player in any way.

- 4.4. Players are not allowed to use a mobile phone for any reason during the tournament. The aforementioned violation results in the said player cards being voided, as well as in the bets (blind bets and mandatory included) being remained in the pot and the specific player is disqualified from the tournament.
- 4.5. The sale or purchase of tournament chips between players is prohibited. Any player found violating this rule, is immediately disqualified from the tournament, the remaining of their chips are removed from the table and the registration fee remains in the drop box.
- 4.6. During the tournament players are not allowed to:
 1. Sit in a position other than the selected and/or indicated by the Casino
 2. Verbally abuse or use physical violence against a Casino employee or a third party
 3. Act out of sequence
 4. Reveal closed cards before any action
 5. Hide closed cards when they should be revealed
 6. Act with intention to remove one or more cards from the table
 7. Act intentionally to avoid paying a blind bet, when moving to a table in order to balance it (all blind bets that are not placed, are paid and placed into the next pot as inactive money)
 8. Do not move directly to an indicated table, to balance it.
 9. Communicate or cooperate with each other or with other parties, in any way, with the intention of influencing the outcome of the tournament.
 10. Violate the tournament terms and conditions or behave in such a way that is harmful to its smooth operation.

Such violations result in a verbal warning or even the disqualification of the player from one or more rounds of the tournament, as well as banning from the table for a specified (and progressively increasing) period of time. The above may also result in all of the player bets (mandatory and blind bets included) remaining in the pot or even their permanent disqualification from the tournament.

- 4.7. When a player is disqualified their remaining chips are removed from the rest of the tournament.
- 4.8. Tournament players sign an agreement in advance, where they consent to the use of their photo, name, audio-visual material in publications, advertisements and any other means of communication (TV, Internet, Radio, Newspapers etc.). Regency Entertainment Tourism and Leisure Single Person S.A. reserves the right to allow third parties to record the venue and the players of the tournament, as well as use this audio-visual material (photos, video, players' names) for advertising and informational purposes in Greece and abroad. By participating in the tournament, players consent and accept the use of audio-visual material by third parties for all aforementioned purposes.
- 4.9. All aforementioned tournament terms are available in the Casino website and in the Casino Table Games area.
- 4.10. Candidates are solely responsible to be informed about the terms of the tournament.
- 4.11. By participating in the Tournament, all players accept that the conditions of the terms of the present are exclusively controlled by the company.
- 4.12. All participants in the Tournament accept that Regency Entertainment Tourism and Leisure Single Person S.A. reserves the right to cancel the tournament, extend it or change and modify the terms and conditions of its conduct, whenever necessary.

- 4.13. In the event of force majeure or any other reason hindering the occurrence of the Tournament on the specified date, the Tournament will either be canceled or rescheduled for another date and time, indicated by Regency Entertainment Tourism and Leisure Single Person S.A.
- 4.14. The Tournament is certified by the present representatives of the Casino and it is final and not amenable to disputes.

1. Who uses your Personal Data

2. What Personal Data do we collect?

1. Name: we collect the first and the last name of our customers when they fill out the registration form, or sign up for our newsletter, or participate in our contests, draws and various promotions.
2. Date of birth and nationality: we collect the date of birth and nationality of our customers when they complete their registration form.
3. Email address, postal address details and mobile phone number: they are collected by registering and participating in tournaments, draws and promotions.
4. Financial and Professional information: such as a settlement note or other documents using Tax Office information, work certificates and a recent payroll copy, required by the law.

5. Information regarding customers' gaming activity: during the provision of our services, required by the law.
6. On line activity data: when company's digital services are used, personal data such as social media account, profile picture, IP address etc. is collected. If the customer chooses to link his/her social media account with the company's digital services, his/her personal data and information may be shared by his/her social media account.
7. Suppliers' & Partners' Details: Suppliers' & Partners' names, registered office address, VAT number, Tax Office Number, IBAN Number etc. are collected for operating and invoicing purposes.

3. How do we collect your personal data?

We collect your personal data through the registration application during your first visit to the casino, when show interest in our services, when you visit our website, or when you subscribe to our newsletter. We do not share your personal data with anyone and we guarantee that no use is made other than as provided by law.

4. Customers' Personal Data is used for:

- Provision of our services: casino entrance, participation in casino games and videotaped poker tournaments.
- Marketing and other promotions, such as participation in draws and tournaments, newsletters, digital communication etc.
- Rewarding and awarding of points and benefits.
- Information regarding an imposing of entry ban or exit from the Casino area.
- Prevention of money laundering and terrorist financing, in accordance with the law.

5. Lawful basis of processing Personal Data:

- Personal Data processing is performed for various regulatory and legal obligations of all Casinos towards the Competent Authorities, in the context of our compliance with national and/or European legislation.
- Personal Data processing is performed for marketing and/or promotional purposes, based on the customer's consent.
- In some cases, Personal Data processing is necessary for legitimate interests' purposes, provided that the customer's rights and legitimate interests do not outweigh the rights of the company.
- Finally, Personal Data processing, is carried out for reasons of public interest, to avoid money laundering and terrorist financing.

6. Duration of Personal Data records maintaining:

- Maintaining customers' personal data records is required by law.
- Customers' personal data records regarding rewarding and loyalty programs (points), is maintained for a period of three (3) months or for the last twenty (20) visits.
- Personal data records regarding suppliers and other partners, are maintained for twenty (20) years, according to tax and administrative authorities requirements.

- Personal data records regarding customers who registered for company's newsletter and other promotions, until personally declared by the customer otherwise.

7. Precautionary Measurements for our Customers' Personal Data Protection

In order to ensure our customers' Personal Data protection from possible loss, corruption, illegal processing or alteration, we take all necessary physical, technical and organizational measurements at all times, such as:

- Use of information systems that minimize processing of personal data
- Access to systems and databases on a «need-to-know» basis.

8. When and how does the Company share Customers' Personal Data with others?

In the context of the Company's cooperation with the Competent Authorities and third-party providers, the Company uses as little as possible of Customers' personal data, demanding strict abidance by the European Legislation. In addition, for more efficient service and promotional updating purposes regarding LIVE ENTERTAINMENT, the Company may transfer the customers' personal data to Vergina Theatro.

9. Customer rights

Customers have the right to request access to their personal data, processed by the Company.

In addition, customers have the following rights:

- The right to correct, delete (in certain cases) as well as limit the use of their personal data.
- The right to withdraw their consent at any time, without affecting the process' legitimacy for the period before the withdrawal of their consent.
- The subject to conditions right to receive their personal data for external use.
