

## **PARTICIPATION GUIDE**

### **COMMERCIAL NAME: MONEY WHEEL WITH TABLE**

#### **CONDUCT RULES AND TERMS OF PARTICIPATION**

“Money Wheel with Table” is a game played with up to twelve (12) players, a wheel which has 52 or 54 pockets and a table for the placement of the bets.

The Dealer or the Inspector shall be responsible for operating the “Money Wheel with Table”. It is upon casino discretion whether the wheel shall be spun clockwise, counterclockwise or towards both directions by turns. The players shall not touch or spin the wheel.

Should the wheel not complete at least three (3) revolutions, the Dealer shall immediately call "no spin", stop the game and start new game.

Players may place their bets on one or more of the special places printed on the baize on the tabletop which correspond to the pockets represented on the wheel. All bets may be placed in cash chips, colour chips or promo chips. The Dealer spins the wheel with three consecutive spins. The players can place any bets during the wheel revolution or change their placed bets, until the Dealer calls "no more bets", while they cannot place any bets until the payments of the previous game have been completed.

When the pointer of the wheel stops inside one of the wheel pockets, the Dealer shall call the winning symbol/combination and places the special dolly on the winning symbol/combination on the special places printed on the baize on the tabletop.

The Dealer shall collect the losing bets and then pay out bets placed on winning symbol/combination to each player in turn.

Winning bets shall be paid out as follows, depending on how they were placed:

- a) Position A bet: 45 to 1.
- b) Position B bet: 45 to 1.
- c) Position C bet: 20 to 1.
- d) Position D bet: 10 to 1.
- e) Position E bet: 5 to 1.
- f) Position F bet: 3 to 1.
- g) Position G bet: 1 to 1.

where the positions A, B, C, D, E, F and G correspond to symbols/combinations/pictures/amounts which the casino selects to depict on the wheel and the tabletop.

Only the Dealer shall exchange money and chips between customers and the float and pay out winning bets. No other Casino staff may handle chips or money while the table is open.

The minimum bet at each table shall be set by the Casino. The maximum bet at each table shall be set by the Casino on the basis of the minimum bet for the table and may be equal up to 50 times the minimum bet and may be different per available wagers.

Over maximum bets are prohibited and the sum over maximum shall be rejected and returned to the player. Bets below the minimum bet are prohibited and returned to the players.

If the over maximum bet was not noticed in time, i.e. before the Dealer called no more bets and the player wins, he shall accept payment on the basis of the predefined maximum bet for the table and refund of the sum over maximum (i.e. the amount bet over the permitted limit). If the player bets over maximum and this was not noticed in time and the player loses, the Dealer shall refund the player the sum over maximum (i.e. the amount bet over the permitted limit).

Call bets which are not physically placed shall not be accepted and no payment shall be made to the player.

Each player shall be solely responsible for placing his bet properly on the baize on the tabletop, either with or without the Dealer's help. If the bet is placed with the Dealer's help, the player shall always be responsible for verifying himself that his instructions to the Dealer for placing the bet have been carried out correctly.

In all events, the bet shall win or lose depending solely on the case in which the pointer rests in one pocket of the wheel.

Should there be physical intervention or mechanical malfunction of the wheel, all bets are voided for the said spin, no matter whether the pointer has stopped in a wheel pocket.

Should the pointer stop on the separation between two pockets, all bets on this spin are voided.
